

How can the music of ChocQuibTown, from the Pacific Coast of Colombia, help you express and celebrate your cultural identity through Rap?

In this lesson you will:

- Explore Rap and Hip Hop as a form of expression
- Define cultural identity
- Learn how to play a ChocQuibTown beat using body percussion
- Practice singing the chorus of "Somos Pacífico" by ChocQuibTown in Spanish
- Discover the importance of a cypher in Rap culture

Who is ChocQuibtown?

ChocQuibTown is a music group from El Chocó - a region on the Pacific Coast in the country of Colombia.

Their music combines Rap with a mix of musical styles unique to the area where they live.

One of their most well-known songs is called, "De Donde Vengo Yo."

What might "De Donde Vengo Yo" mean in English?



"Where I Come From"

"De donde vengo Yo" translates to "Where I come from."

Where you come from is a part of your **Cultural Identity,** or how you think about yourself and your background.

Use this handout to draw a picture of something unique about where you come from. You could draw a picture of food people eat where you come from, games people play, or other activities.



Rapping to "Somos Pacifico"

Then, learn how to create the beat of "Somos Pacifico" with LADAMA by following along with this video.

After that, learn how to sing the chorus of "Somos Pacifico" with this video.



Learning "Somos Pacifico"

Now that you know how to make the beat and sing the chorus to "Somos Pacifico" practice rapping.

Watch <u>this video</u> to learn how to rap over "Somos Pacifico."

Then use this video as a soundtrack to practice rapping.

When a group of rappers perform together, they take turns. This is called a Cypher. With friends, create a cypher using this video as a soundtrack, and rap about where you come from.
