<p>Convergence (Noun): The joining of two or more big ideas or events.</p>	<p>Do the ideas of art, music, and learning converge in your classroom?</p>
<p>Live Music(Noun): Songs that are performed in front of a live audience.</p>	<p>How many times have you seen live music performed?</p>
<p>Phenomenon (Noun): An amazing and unusual person, group, thing, or appearance.</p>	<p>Name a scientific phenomenon that interests you.</p>
<p>Recording Studio (Noun): A place where audio recordings are made.</p>	<p>If you were a musician, would you rather perform live music or create music in a recording studio?</p>
<p>Sensation (Noun): A state of excited interest or feelings experienced by many people.</p>	<p>Name a popular music artist that is a big sensation among you and many of your friends.</p>
<p>Unprecedented (Adjective): Without previous examples, something that was never known or done before.</p>	<p>Would you like to do something that is unprecedented during your life-time?</p>
<p>Work Ethic (Noun): A desire or determination to work hard to accomplish a goal.</p>	<p>Do you have a good work ethic? What is an example of your work ethic?</p>
